NOTE: Original research papers (i.e., Capstone projects, Thesis, Research works) of students are solicited in all aspects including theoretical studies, practical applications, high quality and state-of-the-art ideas and results, new technology, and experimental prototypes. All submitted student research papers will be reviewed and selected by the Special Session Selection Committee on the basis of both their quality and relevance.

### **General Guidelines**

- The Special Session is open for submission of researches from student researchers of any Educational Institutions. Kindly submit student researches directly thru e-mail [intechconverge@gmail.com](mailto:intechconverge@gmail.com).
- The special session organizing committee will be responsible for the review and selection of student researches to be included in the special session.



- Student researches to be submitted must follow the paper template indicated in the Paper Submission Guidelines of the CITC 2021 with a maximum of 12 pages including the abstract of up to 300 words.
  
- Student Authors of the special session will be required to submit their full papers (with revisions according to the review results).
  
- Important Dates:
  - Student Research Submission Deadline: October 15, 2021
  - Acceptance Notification: October 29, 2021
  - Full Paper Submission and Registration Due: November 12, 2021
  - Presentation Dates: December 9-11, 2021
  
- The guidelines for the student research presentations will be as follows:
  - The assigned session chair will facilitate the special session presentations.
  - A panel of evaluators will also be assigned to evaluate the student research presentations aiming to strengthen and solidify their research contents.
  - All presentations will be made online through video conferencing, thus, attendees and presenters must have a Google Meet App [Account] installed in their respective laptops, PCs, tablets, or smartphones.
  - A meeting invite will be sent through e-mail with an embedded video conference link where the meeting ID and password can be found.
